

Class Rules:

When a long-term assignment such as a major writing assignment, research paper, project that is assigned several days ahead, is due, I expect it to be submitted on time, even if you have an excused absence that day. Your absence from class does NOT excuse you from work. Tests will be taken on the day they are assigned to be taken regardless of whether you were present the day(s) before. All essays, projects, etc. are due according to the calendar.
- 4. Stay in your assigned seat unless given permission to move.
- 5. Be respectful to me and to everyone else in the class.
