Choose <i>three</i> unfamiliar vocabulary words from each chapter. Write the word, a definition, and sentence. Do NOT use your vocabulary words. List the chapter where you found each word.	Complete the Anticipation Guide for the novel. On a separate sheet of paper, write an explanation for three of your choices. List the original statement and at least a paragraph response for each.	Explain the meaning or symbolism of at least <i>eight</i> character's names. Why do you think Rand chose the names that she did? How do they add meaning to the story?	Relate, in essay form, a time when you were in the minority. How did you react? Or, relate a time when you conformed to fit the rest of the group.
Create a Freytag's Pyramid of the story. Include the exposition, rising action, climax, falling action, and resolution. Label the events of the story according to their place on the chart. Complete the entire chart.	Write a letter from Equality to Liberty in which he explains how he is feeling about her and his situation. Equality has just seen Liberty and does not know her name yet. Make sure to use the same language that Equality would use--we. Letter should be two to three paragraphs.	In chart form, compare and contrast our society with the Anthem society. Also compare other 2 other types of societies with <i>Anthem</i> (i.e. Communism) Compare gender roles, laws, customs, and more.	Through an art medium (drawing, painting, etc.), depict the change of Equality from the beginning of the novel to the end. (must use color) In paragraph form explain the following. Did he change? If so, how?
Place the occupations or roles in the society in order of importance from the least to most. Include a brief description of their duties and which of the characters fit under these categories. Explain why you ranked them in the order you chose.	How would you feel if you lived in a society like Equality's? What would you do if you were in his situation? Write <i>three</i> diary entries as if you were living in his society. Include dates from the story's time period. Write in the style of character from the novel. Each entry should be a paragraph long.	Complete the Problematic Situation for the novel. You will need a group of <i>three</i> for this activity. Each must submit individual and group lists. Each member should write or type his own assignment. Write group member names on this box.	Write an additional chapter to the end of the novel, showing what you believe has happened to the characters <i>ten</i> years later. Imitate (not copy) the writing style of the novel.
