<p>Surrealist Traits – must have at least five of these traits</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Absurd; Abstract (Miro- <i>Head of a Woman</i>) ▪ Alienation; isolation (Max Ernest) ▪ Curves; continuous movement; molten forms; liquid shapes (Dali, Masson, Magritte) ▪ Dream like qualities (Dali- <i>The Persistence of Memory</i>) ▪ Element of surprise (Dali- <i>The Metamorphosis of Narcissus</i>) ▪ Expose truth by taking away normal order and significance (Magritte - <i>Son of Man</i> and <i>Bowler Hat</i>) ▪ Liberate the imagination (Masson) ▪ Mental adventure (Escher) ▪ Reach into the psyche (Dali - <i>The Persistence of Memory</i>) ▪ Real figures weirdly altered (Celebes - <i>The Elephant</i>) ▪ Takes ordinary objects out of their traditional places (Magritte, Dali, Oppenheim, Ernest) ▪ Thought provoking (Giacometti, Magritte) ▪ Unexpected juxtapositions (Giorgio de Chirico- <i>The Red Tower</i>, Magritte) ▪ Unexpected settings for regular items (Joan Miro) ▪ Unorganized images and thoughts (Jean Arp) ▪ Viewed by the subconscious (Jean Arp) 	Two or more elements missing/ ineffective/ weak	Three elements present; two missing/ ineffective/ weak	Four elements present; one missing/ ineffective/ weak	Five present and beautiful
	<p>Things you can't have in surrealist art (i.e. these don't count as traits)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the art work itself cannot have a function (painted shoes, t-shirts, etc can't be used) • the art work can't just be weird or random • no religious imagery • no war or gun references • no outer space settings • your painting must have a background - the blank spots of your paper don't count as background • no computer help; computers didn't exist during the movement • don't make it modern art 			
<p>Mediums</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At least two separate art mediums are used • Mediums must be distinctly OBVIOUS - watercolors and paint aren't obviously different (colored pencil and pencil are the same) (Ray Man - <i>A Day and Night</i>) • Identify the two mediums during your presentation 	One element; one element is very questionable	Two elements but one sketchy or questionable	Almost perfect; two mediums; but one is ineffective or not obvious	Perfect; obvious mediums; both are identified
<p>Title</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have a title • Must explain the work 	No title; inappropriate title; does not relate at all	Title is sketchy or questionable	Almost perfect; title somewhat relates of explains work	Perfect; obvious title; title relates or explains work
<p>Meaning</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be some meaning to the work • Don't say you don't know something about your work; you are its creator • Don't just make up stuff on presentation day. THINK! 	No meaning; inappropriate meaning; does not relate at all	Meaning is sketchy or questionable	Almost perfect; somewhat makes sense	Perfect; meaningful; makes sense; makes work's meaning obvious
<p>Work/ Effort</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Spent class time working ▪ Did not spend class time talking/ gossiping/ socializing ▪ cooperation during cleaning up the classroom ▪ work must look like it took time to complete ▪ don't work on it during class on the presentation day 	Little or no effort in class; little or no work accomplished in class	Questionable work habits	Almost perfect; worked most days;	Perfect; worked everyday in class; no talking/ gossiping/ socializing
<p>Presentation Grammar/ Mechanics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No grammatical errors • No pronunciation errors • No gum chewing, giggling, leaning, using podium, etc 	Three or more errors	Two errors	One error	Perfect ; no errors
